It was a great opportunity to play from tees they wouldn't normally use. The "sand bagging" team of Mike Prewitt, Pat Ford, Roger Pierce, and Mark Chester beat the field with a net 18 under. Pat Ford also won the KP on 13 with a shot to 32 inches. However, the most incredible shot of the day was by Rich Rosenberg who made an albatross 2 on #18. Congratulations, Rich on making the rarest shot in golf.

The second Men's Club event, a Horse Race, was held at 5:00pm on June 22. Eight teams participated with five of them advancing to the final hole. All five teams ended up in a chip off for win, place, and show. Ultimately, the team of Mike Clark and Roger Pierce won; Gary Boonstra and Gene Cushway were second; and Jon Cooper and Tim Wyer finished third. Pat Ford won the KP on #2 and Denny Behrman won the KP on #7.

Our July events will be held on the 13th and 27th. July 13 will be a 1:00 shotgun, 18-hole team best ball and July 27 will be a 5:00 shotgun, 9-hole two-man Chapman. 
